FEES

Since 1978 Gil has been touring all summer seasons in Europe and performed nearly twenty concerts each year.

All travel and lodging expenses were under the responsibility of the promoters. The fee is as follows:

From 1978 to 1982 - US\$ 6 000 for concert

From 1982 to 1988 - US\$ 8 000 for concert

From 1988 to 1990 - US\$ 10 000 for concert

From 1991 to 1993 - US\$ 12 000 for concert

From 1993 to 1996 - US\$ 15.000 for concert

From 1996 to 1998 - US\$ 18.000 for concert
